Specific Objective

- Prepare and submit policy recommendations to the governmental structures to better reflect the need based support to poor children and their families in Georgia

Goals

- Identify the needs of support for poor children and their families in Georgia
- Increase awareness of stakeholders about negative implications of child poverty
- Enhance stakeholders' participation in finding solutions to the identified problems
- Develop policy level strategies how to support poor children and their families meet their needs in long-term perspective

Main Activities

- Conduct Georgian child welfare policy analysis
- Conduct stakeholder analysis in terms of service provision for poor children and their families
- Assess the needs of poor children and their families

Main Activities

- Introduce the needs assessment findings to the stakeholders (State, NGOs, local and international organizations, community members and beneficiaries)
- Organize focus group discussions among stakeholders on finding solution to the problems faced by poor children and their families
- Summarize discussion inputs and prepare recommendations
- Submit recommendations to the relevant state body



Target Groups

- Children and their families living in poverty lacking their basic needs

Partners

- Governmental structures working on childcare and social welfare
- Local NGOs, international organizations and Professional Associations
- Experts/professionals in social welfare and childcare

Expected Outcomes

- Need oriented child welfare policy is promoted
- Practice of civil society involvement in decision making process is enhanced
- Concerns of poor children and their families are brought to the government's attention
- The knowledge of stakeholders about the importance of combating child poverty is increased
