 - ❑ To introduce new IT tools and special soft programs (e.g. "National Fraud Initiative")

Action Plan - Outputs

- A pool of trained professional technocratic auditors in the core anticorruption body of the country
 - Annual oversight of state expenditures

Action Plan - Outcomes

- ❑ More **efficient** use of resources like time, funds and people
 - ❑ Further growth of **accountability and transparency**
 - ❑ Increased impact on policy making and the effectiveness of anticorruption work at the national level
