OR WHY WE NEED TO DO IT NOW

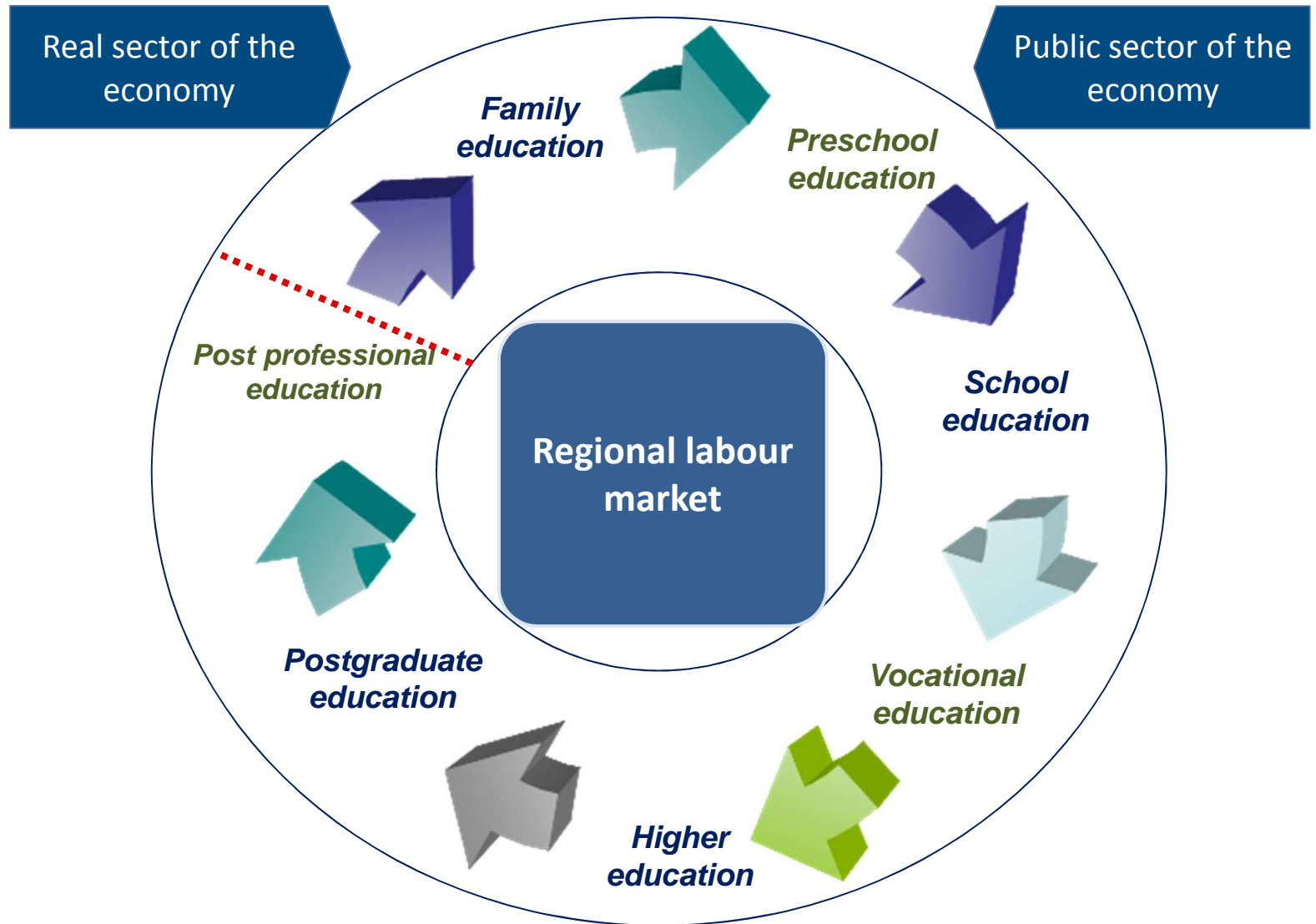
1. **Difficult demographic situation in Ukraine**, as a result of accelerated depopulation and aging of the population.
2. **Radical changes in production and consumption technologies** (discrepancies between professional status of work force and requirements of employers are increasing).

Region is lack of high qualified work force demanded by direct foreign investors

3. **Growing variety of informational requests from various categories of the population** (existing system of education does not meet requirements of new needs of the society and of an individual).

Main priority in developing system of education in Donetsk region in 2011-2012:



LLL Programme would comprises 3 of projects aimed to:

“Trinity for the better region development and growth”



- modernise existing system of education for government servants using the business tools to manage the reforms challenges;



- form innovative learning environment for unemployed youth and existing SMS in closer Partnership with Media;



- create and introduce a multi component LLL model (including the mutual funding) into the system of self-government in Donetsk Region for communities and local governments to work in partnership from the very beginning of any public project.
